

Antun Jurinić, univ.mag.physioth. is the Chief Physiotherapist of the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at Sveti Duh Clinical Hospital in Zagreb and a lecturer at the Faculty of Health Sciences, Libertas International University, Zagreb.

An author of numerous scientific papers, professional manuals, and books, his most recent publications include Physiotherapy Propaedeutics (as editor and author) and History of Physiotherapy in Croatia (as contributing author).

Mr Jurinić served as president of two national physiotherapy organizations: the Croatian Association of Physiotherapists (1998–1999) and the Croatian Chamber of Physiotherapists (2000–2015).

His editorial work includes more than ten conference proceedings and editorship of the journals Fizioterapija (1996–2000) and Fizioinfo (2003–2006).

Professional interests focus on dynamic spinal stability, the phenomenology and theory of physiotherapy, and problem-based learning in physiotherapy education.

He received the HZF Golden Award for exceptional contribution to the development of physiotherapy in 2005 and the Lifetime Achievement Award in 2025.
